MINUTES OF COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 8 JANUARY 2019 AT 5.30 P.M. IN THE NUNSMOOR CENTRE

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS COMMITTEE MEETING held on 4 December had been distributed to Committee members. There was discussion about the establishment of a community garden on plots 64/65a; the Council would not support the project although it was felt that the committee should have the autonomy to allow the scheme to proceed. It was agreed that (after checking Moorside's lease with the Council) the proposition to use the space as a community garden would be taken forward for discussion at the AGM on 30 January. At present the association must hold an AGM in January; it was proposed that there should be some flexibility in the timing of the AGM and that this would also be taken forward for discussion on 30 January.
